1) 報名手續

- 1.1 請將填妥的報名表格連同支票 (支票抬頭請填寫「耀中語藝教育中心有限公司」,於支票 背面寫上學生姓名、聯絡電話號碼及課程編號),寄交九龍塘多福道3號 — 耀中語藝教 育中心註冊組收。若資料、支票及/或文件不全,恕不辦理。
- 1.2 取錄通知:除個別課程設有特定的入學要求外,報名以先到先得為準。學生最遲將於開課
 4 天前收到取錄通知。如在開課前2天內尚未收到任何通知,請致電本中心查詢。
- 1.3 新生如需進行課前評估,費用為 HK\$100,此費用不得退回,亦不能轉讓。評估日期一經安 排,不得更改,否則需另繳評估費用。
- 1.4 電郵地址:本中心將以電郵方式通知家長最新消息,敬請家長清晰填寫電郵地址。

2) 退學 / 退費

- 2.1 除報名不獲取錄或課程取消外,所繳學費恕不退回,亦不能轉讓。
- 2.2 如有特別理由,本中心將考慮是否接納退款申請。申請必須於開課前以書面提出。如本中心 接納其退款申請,退款安排將作如下處理:
 - 取錄通知發出前提出退款申請者,將從退款中扣除 HK\$200 作行政費用(以每課程計算)。
 - 取錄通知發出後提出退款申請者,將不獲退款。
- 2.3 課程如因按教育局指引而取消,將不獲安排退費或補課。

Enrolment Information

1) Enrolment

- 1.1 Please send completed application form and cheque (make the cheque(s) payable to "Yew Chung Arts & Language Centre Ltd.", write the student's name, contact phone number and course code on the back of the cheque) to *Enrolment Section YewChung Arts & Language Centre: 3 To Fuk Road, Kowloon Tong.* The Centre reserves the right not to process any application if the necessary items are not furnished.
- 1.2 Enrolment is on a first-come-first-served basis unless special admission requirements are stated. Applicants will receive notification of admission (or otherwise) at least 4 days before course commencement. If no notification is received within 2 days of course commencement, please call us to enquire.
- 1.3 YALC will charge a non-refundable pre-admission assessment fee of HK\$100 for any new students when necessary. Upon confirmation of assessment date & time, changes are not permitted.
- 1.4 The Centre will send latest news to parents via email. Please write your email address clearly.

2) <u>Withdrawals and Refund</u>

- 2.1 No refund will be made unless application for enrolment is not accepted or the course applied for is cancelled.
- 2.2 Requests for withdrawal will be considered under special circumstances. Such requests should be made in writing before course commencement. If granted, the fee arrangement will be as follows:
 - Written request received before confirmation letter issued: an administration fee of HK\$200 (per each course) will be levied.
 - Written request received after confirmation letter issued: No refund will be made.
- 2.3 If classes are cancelled in accordance with Education Bureau's (EDB) guideline(s) or announcement, no refund or makeup class will be arranged.
- 2.4 Neither a replacement class nor a refund will be arranged to student absent from class due to sickness or personal affairs.

3) Class Date, Time & Venue

- 3.1 Please check class date, time and venue as listed in the confirmation letter.
- 3.2 Please note any holidays as outlined in the confirmation letter. No further reminder will be made unless there are changes.

4) Typhoon and Rainstorm

4.1 Please note the following class arrangement when the weather condition is severe:

3.	In force suddenly while classes are in progress	Classes in progress will continue until normal class finish time

- 4.2 Classes will be held as normal when Yellow Rainstorm, Typhoon Signal No. 1 or 3 is hoisted.
- 4.3 For classes cancelled due to severe weather conditions, no refund or make-up classes will be arranged.
- 4.4 Students will not be notified individually. Parents are requested to pay attention to the Hong Kong Observatory weather reports and exercise their discretion in deciding whether or not to send their children to school when the weather is unstable.

5) Other Rules and Regulations

- 5.1 Parents and guardians are solely responsible for the safety of the students before and after class.
- 5.2 Parents are requested to wait outside the campus while class is in progress. Our staff have the right to ask any person to leave the premises.
- 5.3 For classes lasting for 2 hours or more each session, there is a short break. Parents are encouraged to prepare some drinks and snacks for their child to enjoy during the break.
- 5.4 Student under aged 6 will be given one Pick-up Pass on the first day of class for each term. Parents are requested to present the Pick-up Pass to our staff whenever entering the campus(es) throughout the whole term. Parents without a pick-up pass will be requested to fill out a form and provide their HKID No. and signature. Parents are also expected to present their HKID to our staff for verification when requested to do so. A request for an additional issue of Pick-up Pass will be required to pay \$20 for the administration fee.
- 5.5 Please notify the Centre in writing if there is any change in the contact number, correspondence address, phone, fax, email and the student's school and/or year of study.
- 5.6 The provision of courses is subject to the sole discretion of the Centre. The Centre reserves the right:
 - (a) to cancel courses if the number of applications falls below the required minimum;
 - (b) to change the time, date, venue, and instructor of course should this be necessary, and
